1. I will receive care from my primary physician or another appointed physician.
2. I understand the goal of hospice is to reduce symptoms and promote freedom from pain, discomfort, anxiety and all disturbing symptoms of my life limiting illness. In addition, I understand that care is not intended to be curative or to alleviate the illness, but to the extent possible, to reduce the discomfort of the symptom(s).
3. The choices related to cardiac resuscitation were discussed with me. I further understand that Gilchrist Hospice Care staff do not participate in CPR, however, call 911 if that is consistent with my wishes.
4. The Gilchrist Hospice Care team of physician, nurse(s), social worker, hospice aide, volunteer, bereavement counselor and chaplain will provide physical, emotional, social and spiritual support to me, my primary care giver, and any significant others involved in my life within the limits of Gilchrist Hospice Care's resources.
5. If I am to receive the full benefits of hospice care, it is important to make my needs known to the Gilchrist Hospice Care staff. I and/or my Primary Caregiver will actively participate in plans for my care.
6. In the event that I elect to move my residence within the Gilchrist Hospice Care service area, I understand that I can continue to receive hospice care from Gilchrist Hospice Care.
